

Qualifications Coverage

Cars and drivers cannot simply buy their way in to a spot in the Indy500. They have to earn it through a process called “qualifications” which happens during the day on the Saturday and Sunday prior to the Race.

The only station that broadcasts from Indianapolis Motor Speedway the entire month of May providing wall-to-wall coverage (not simply reports but broadcasting entire day) of Qualifications.

The process for the race cars to qualify includes participating teams driving four laps as fast as they can being the only car on the track. Then the average of that “time trial” is taken and the cars & drivers with the top 33 speeds “qualify” for the Indianapolis 500.
